

The history is rich, with Buddhas, maharajas, British imperialists and brutal clashes between ethnic groups. Despite widespread poverty, the country is now experiencing an economic upswing. In the coming decades, India will become a key global player in line with China, the US, Russia, and the EU. It is therefore important to shine the spotlight on this up-and-coming superpower. With this book you will get a well-written and informative introduction to the country, richly illustrated.
